Circulation

General Collection – For undergraduate students, books are due in twenty-eight (28) days.

For graduate students, books are due at the beginning of February and August.

For faculty, books are due at the beginning of October.

Periodicals - Bound journals are due in two (2) days. Unbound issues may circulate for two (2) hours.

Reserves - Reserve books are due in two (2) hours. They may be taken overnight beginning one (1) hour before closing.

Recalls – are due within seven (7) days of the notice being sent. Material recalled for Reserves are due back immediately.

ILL

Interlibrary Loan of books and journal articles should be requested online. All requestors must register with the University Libraries' ILL service via:

Specify the location as “Engineering Library” to have your items delivered to this library.

The time it will take to receive Interlibrary Loans requested will vary, depending on availability.
